

### **Technique: Opportunities for Wonder**

Provide an experience for students where they can explore or see the content of your curriculum in an image, exploration, demonstration, or video. This can be the launching point for students to ‘wonder’ about that idea and then generate questions that they would like to answer related to a topic. These questions can be posted as ‘We Wonder’ or written in their notebooks. It is important to go back to these questions whenever the unit addresses any of them.

Generating questions can be done using techniques referred to in the past, including (but not limited to):

- Text mapping scrolls
- Using images and videos
- Cornell Note-Taking System
- The frame
- Concept mapping
